

## Verses referenced on the chart (& a few others)

Note: The CLV (Concordant Literal Version) uses “eon” for “aion”, and “eonian” for “aionian”

### *He makes the aions*

#### Hebrews 1:2

KJV: Hath in these last days spoken unto us by *his* Son, whom he hath appointed heir of all things, by whom **also he made the worlds;**  
Greek: και τους αιωνας εποιησεν CLV: “...**He also makes the eons;**”

### *Before the aions*

#### 1 Corinthians 2:7

KJV: But we speak the wisdom of God in a mystery, *even* the hidden *wisdom*, which God ordained **before the world** unto our glory:  
Greek: προ των αιωνων CLV: “...**before the eons...**”

#### Titus 1:2

KJV: In hope of **eternal life**, which God, that cannot lie, promised **before the world began;**  
Greek: επ ελπιδι ζωης αιωνιου ην επηγγειλατο ο αψευδης θεος προ χρονων αιωνιων  
CLV: “in expectation of **life eonian**, which God, Who does not lie, promised **before times eonian;**”

#### 2 Timothy 1:9

KJV: 9 Who hath saved us, and called *us* with an holy calling, not according to our works, but according to his own purpose and grace, which was given us in Christ Jesus **before the world began,**  
Greek: προ χρονων αιωνιων CLV: “...**before times eonian,**”

### *the purpose of the aions*

#### Ephesians 3:11

KJV: According to the **eternal purpose** which he purposed in Christ Jesus our Lord:  
Greek: προθεσιν των αιωνων CLV: “...**purpose of the eons...**”

### *this aion*

#### Matthew 12:32

KJV: And whosoever speaketh a word against the Son of man, it shall be forgiven him: but whosoever speaketh against the Holy Ghost, it shall not be forgiven him, **neither in this world, neither in the world to come.**  
Greek: ουτε εν τουτω τω αιωνι ουτε εν τω μελλοντι CLV: “...**neither in this eon nor in that which is impending.**”

#### Mark 4:19

KJV: And **the cares of this world,** and the deceitfulness of riches, and the lusts of other things entering in, choke the word, and it becometh unfruitful.  
Greek: αι μεριμναι του αιωνος τουτου CLV: “...**the worries of this eon...**”

#### Luke 20:34, 35

KJV: And Jesus answering said unto them, **The children of this world** marry, and are given in marriage:  
Greek: οι υιοι του αιωνος τουτου CLV: “...**The sons of this eon...**”

Romans 12:2

KJV: And **be not conformed to this world**: but be ye transformed by the renewing of your mind, that ye may prove what *is* that good, and acceptable, and perfect, will of God.

Greek: μη συσχηματιζεσθε τω αιωνι τουτου CLV: "...**not to be configured to this eon**..."

1 Corinthians 2:6, 8

KJV: Howbeit we speak wisdom among them that are perfect: yet not the wisdom of **this world**, nor of the princes of **this world**, that come to nought:

Greek: του αιωνος τουτου... του αιωνος τουτου CLV: "...**this eon**...**this eon**..."

KJV: Which none of **the princes of this world** knew: for had they known *it*, they would not have crucified the Lord of glory.

Greek: των αρχοντων του αιωνος τουτου CLV: "...**the chief men of this eon**..."

*the end of the aion*

Matthew 13:39, 40

KJV: The enemy that sowed them is the devil; the harvest is **the end of the world**; and the reapers are the angels.

Greek: συντελεια του αιωνος CLV: "...**the conclusion of the eon**..."

KJV: As therefore the tares are gathered and burned in the fire; so shall it be in **the end of this world**.

Greek: τη συντελεια του αιωνος τουτου CLV: "...**the conclusion of the eon**..."

Matthew 24:3

KJV: And as he sat upon the mount of Olives, the disciples came unto him privately, saying, Tell us, when shall these things be? and what *shall be* the sign of thy coming, and of **the end of the world**?

Greek: της συντελειας του αιωνος CLV: "...**the conclusion of the eon**?"

Matthew 28:20

KJV: Teaching them to observe all things whatsoever I have commanded you: and, lo, I am with you alway, *even* unto **the end of the world**. Amen.

Greek: της συντελειας του αιωνος CLV: "...**the conclusion of the eon**..."

*the coming aion (also "that aion")*

*the coming aions*

Mark 10:30

KJV: But he shall receive an hundredfold now in this time, houses, and brethren, and sisters, and mothers, and children, and lands, with persecutions; and in **the world to come eternal life**.

Greek: τω αιωνι τω ερχομενω ζωην αιωνιον CLV: "...**the coming eon, life eonian**..."

Luke 18:30

KJV: Who shall not receive manifold more in this present time, and in **the world to come life everlasting**.

Greek: τω αιωνι τω ερχομενω ζωην αιωνιον CLV: "...**the coming eon, life eonian**..."

Luke 20:35

KJV: But they which shall be accounted worthy to obtain **that world**, and the resurrection from the dead, neither marry, nor are given in marriage:

Greek: του αιωνος εκεινου CLV: "...**that eon**..."

Ephesians 2:7

KJV: That in **the ages to come** he might shew the exceeding riches of his grace in *his* kindness toward us through Christ Jesus.

Greek: τοις αιωσιν τοις επερχομε CLV: "...**the oncoming eons**,..."

*the end of the aions*  
*the ends of the aions*

Hebrews 9:26

KJV: For then must he often have suffered since the foundation of the world: but now once in **the end of the world** hath he appeared to put away sin by the sacrifice of himself.

Greek: συντελεια των αιωνων εις CLV: "...**the conclusion of the eons**,..."

1 Corinthians 10:11

KJV: Now all these things happened unto them for ensamples: and they are written for our admonition, upon whom **the ends of the world** are come.

Greek: τα τελη των αιωνων CLV: "...**the consummations of the eons**..."

*Aionian life by faith*

Matthew 25:46b

KJV: ...but the righteous into **life eternal**.

Greek: ζωην αιωνιον CLV: "...**life eonian**."

John 3:16

KJV: For God so loved the world, that he gave his only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in him should not perish, but have **everlasting life**.

Greek: ζωην αιωνιον CLV: "...**life eonian**."

1 Timothy 4:10

KJV: For therefore we both labour and suffer reproach, because we trust in the living God, who is the Saviour of all men, **specially** of those that believe.

*Aionian death and punishment*

Matthew 18:8b

KJV: ...it is better for thee to enter into life halt or maimed, rather than having two hands or two feet to be cast into **everlasting fire**.

Greek: το πυρ το αιωνιον CLV: "...**fire eonian**"

Matthew 25:46a

KJV: And these shall go away into **everlasting punishment**:...

Greek: κολασιν αιωνιον CLV: "...**chastening eonian**,..."

Mark 3:29

KJV: But he that shall blaspheme against the Holy Ghost **hath never forgiveness**, but is in danger of **eternal damnation**:

Greek: Mark 3:29 ...ουκ εχει αφεσιν εις τον αιωνα ... αιωνιου κρισεως

CLV: "...**having no pardon for the eon**, but is liable to the **eonian penalty**..."

2 Thessalonians 1:9

Who shall be **punished with everlasting destruction** from the presence of the Lord, and from the glory of his power;

Greek: δικην τισουσιν ολεθρον αιωνιον CLV: "...**incur the justice of eonian extermination**..."

*The goal*

1 Corinthians 15:24-28

24 Then *cometh* the end, when he shall have delivered up the kingdom to God, even the Father; when he shall have put down all rule and all authority and power. 25 For he must reign, till he hath put all enemies under his feet. 26 The last enemy *that* shall be destroyed *is* death. 27 For he hath put all things under his feet. But when he saith all things are put under *him*, *it is* manifest that he is excepted, which did put all things under him. 28 And when all things shall be subdued unto him, then shall the Son also himself be subject unto him that put all things under him, **that God may be all in all**.

## ***No death***

1 Corinthians 15:26

The last enemy *that* shall be destroyed *is* death.

## ***All saved***

John 1:29

The next day John seeth Jesus coming unto him, and saith, Behold the Lamb of God, which taketh away the sin of the world.

John 12:32

And I, if I be lifted up from the earth, will draw all men unto me.

Romans 5:18-19

18 Therefore as by the offence of one *judgment came upon all men* to condemnation; even so by the righteousness of one *the free gift came upon all men* unto justification of life. 19 For as by one man's disobedience many were made sinners, so by the obedience of one shall many be made righteous.

Romans 11:32

For God hath concluded them all in unbelief, that he might have mercy upon all.

1 Corinthians 13:8a

Charity never faileth:

1 Corinthians 15:22-28

22 For as in Adam all die, even so in Christ shall all be made alive. 23 But every man in his own order: Christ the firstfruits; afterward they that are Christ's at his coming. 24 Then *cometh* the end, when he shall have delivered up the kingdom to God, even the Father; when he shall have put down all rule and all authority and power. 25 For he must reign, till he hath put all enemies under his feet. 26 The last enemy that shall be destroyed is death. 27 For he hath put all things under his feet. But when he saith all things are put under *him*, *it is* manifest that he is excepted, which did put all things under him. 28 And when all things shall be subdued unto him, then shall the Son also himself be subject unto him that put all things under him, that God may be all in all.

2 Corinthians 5:19

To wit, that God was in Christ, reconciling the world unto himself, not imputing their trespasses unto them; and hath committed unto us the word of reconciliation.

Ephesians 1:9-10

9 Having made known unto us the mystery of his will, according to his good pleasure which he hath purposed in himself: 10 That in the dispensation of the fulness of times he might gather together in one all things in Christ, both which are in heaven, and which are on earth; *even* in him:

Colossians 1:15-20

15 Who is the image of the invisible God, the firstborn of every creature: 16 For by him were all things created, that are in heaven, and that are in earth, visible and invisible, whether *they be* thrones, or dominions, or principalities, or powers: all things were created by him, and for him: 17 And he is before all things, and by him all things consist. 18 And he is the head of the body, the church: who is the beginning, the firstborn from the dead; that in all *things* he might have the preeminence. 19 For it pleased *the Father* that in him should all fulness dwell; 20 And, having made peace through the blood of his cross, by him to reconcile all things unto himself; by him, I say, whether they be things in earth, or things in heaven.

1 Timothy 2:4

Who will have all men to be saved, and to come unto the knowledge of the truth.

1 Timothy 4:10

For therefore we both labour and suffer reproach, because we trust in the living God, who is the Saviour of all men, specially of those that believe.

James 5:11

Behold, we count them happy which endure. Ye have heard of the patience of Job, and have seen the end of the Lord; that the Lord is very pitiful, and of tender mercy.

1 John 2:2
