Minutes of the last EAA 919 meeting.

December 12, 2008

The meeting was held at Mike & Barb Thern's home.

Meeting was called to order by Mike Thern at 7:23 PM.

The treasurer reported the balance on hand was \$2356.94.

The annual election was held. Nominees were Rob Ossell for President, Dan Bass for VP, Helen Marsolek for Treasurer, and Walt Kelly for Secretary. There being no contested offices, a unanimous ballot for the candidates was cast and they were dully elected.

Russ proposed a "Poker Run" flight in January and will organize one.

Russ proposed that a group consider going to the "ACES" facility at the Mall of America where they have a set of flight simulators for great Dog-Fights. Cost is about \$45/hr and includes a free briefing video. Eleven members expressed interest and February 21st was suggested as a potential date.

Mike Thern opened a discussion on courtesy cars on airports, city support of airports, and an invitation for Chapter members to attend the Rushford Airport Commission meetings, the next one being December 15.

The January meeting will be held at Tom Lee's home (1329 W. Wincrest Dr.) on the 16th if Fred Peterson will have the program, and at the Marsolek home (1176 W. 5th) if the program is other than Fred. See note below (program change)!

Meeting adjourned at 8:05.

Discussions included:

Bill Davidson commented on discussions with FBOs regarding assistance from local units of government. He cited examples such as Columbus, OH having a picnic shelter, Willmar, MN having 4 courtesy cars, two being ex-police cars apparently owned by the City and carried under the city insurance policy at little or no extra cost, and the other two carrying liability insurance only.
