Please plan to attend if at all possible.

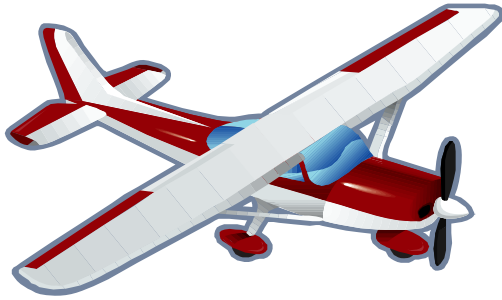
